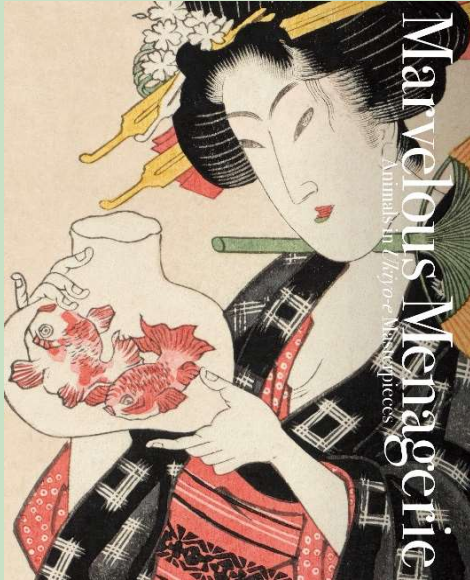


Marvelous Menagerie
